


3.2 RITE Kickoff Event




Transportation board games introducing new members

4. FINANCES

RITE has a bank account with Alterna Saving at their branch located at Bay St. and College St. as the Ryerson Branch closed. Under the name "Ryerson CITE Student Chapter" RITE has a pay-as-you-go chequing account, which results in monthly charge for paper statements used for financial records.

The past year has been a relatively quiet, as there were some substantial changes in management and restructuring in of the executive members. The delays in the setup of the executive committee means that most reimbursements occurred late in the year.

CITE funded RITE's competition in the 2018 Traffic Bowl in Edmonton. Several of the organizations at Ryerson including the undergraduate and graduate engineering departments also provided funding. This combination allowed RITE to put substantial amounts for use in the 2019 Traffic Bowl as funding is expected to be significantly less this year. RITE plans to send 4 members to the conference and competition this year and the costs will be reflected in next year's budget.
